Play peek-a-boo or hide-and-seek.	Read a fairy tale together.	Sing your favorite song.	Talk to your baby about your day, and ask children who can talk to tell you about their days.	Finger paint with washable paints or shaving cream.
Play with items around your house, such as empty boxes or wooden spoons.	Read a poem together.	Make Up a song about your favorite animal.	Talk about the weather! Is it hot or cold? Is it raining, snowing, or windy	Sing the alphabet song and clap once for each letter.
Pretend you are Little Red Riding Hood going to Grandmother's house. What food would you bring in your basket?	Read a book that makes you laugh.	Check out or download a children's CD and listen to one of the songs.	? Describe to your baby what you see outside your car window, or ask children who can talk to tell you what they can see.	Place masking tape on your child's high chair or on the tabletop, and encourage your child to pull it up, building his or her finger and hand muscles.
Act like your favorite animal.	Tel a story using just the illustrations	Sing "Mary Had a Little Lamb" but use different animals.	Go for a walk outside and talk about the things you see.	Create your own writing activity!
Make up your own play activity!	Read a nursery rhyme together	Make up a song about what you did today.	Make up your own activity!!	Color a picture with your child!
